- *InformationNOW* – a next-generation, Web-based student information system that provides a complete solution for the collection, analysis and reporting of student data, accessible through a customizable portal for each user. With *InformationNOW*, administrators, teachers, parents and school health professionals can search within multiple data sets and integrate data to produce informative and valuable reports specified to their needs. By providing quick access and insight into student data, district leaders can make more informed decisions for efficient and effective school management, educators can better understand the needs of their students to maximize learning, and parents can be more involved in their children's education. Add-on modules allow for management of lunch program services, health services, and school-home communications, and enable electronic transcript exchange.

Administrators are able to compile reports of aggregate and disaggregate data in the STI system to meet local and federal reporting requirements, and use the information to make critical decisions regarding resource allocation, budgeting, and professional development.
